



## Rhymes, Rhymes, Rhymes Series With Kenn Nesbitt



In this series of Passports: Adventure in Learning, students will explore the literary elements of rhymes and repeated sounds. Students will listen to Kenn Nesbitt, a published writer, as he reads his funny poetry and discusses what a rhyme is, as well as what a rhyme is not. As students actively participate in funny and entertaining rhymes and poems with Kenn, they will develop a greater understanding of the sounds and syllables of letters and words. ### Students will:

- Identify and combine syllables
- Produce rhyming words
- Distinguish between rhyming and non-rhyming words
- Isolate initial, middle ending sounds
- Use common spelling patterns to decode words
- Read and recognize genre of poetry
- Generate ideas for writing
- Use nouns and verbs
